Preface

We are delighted to the publication of the picture guide of forest trees in Cambodia volume 3. This volume focuses on Deciduous Dipterocarp Forest (DDF) which is widely distributed at lowland throughout Cambodia, in Kratie.

To enrich our knowledge of the flora of Kratie, botanical inventories were conducted in the Permanent Sample Plots (PSPs) and the community forest (CF) in Kratie province (12° 43' N, 106° 04'E, alt. 43–48 m) in 4 & 9 June 2011 and 13–14 October 2012. Totally, we collected 118 specimens from our survey, and identified 88 species of 45 trees, 16 shrubs, 15 vines, 9 herbs, 1 palm, 1 cycad and 1 fern in 74 genera in 38 families. Voucher specimens were deposited in the herbarium of Forest Administration of Cambodia and the Museum of Kyushu University (FU).

All of them are not rare but common species in Cambodia, thus, in addition to the previous volumes 1 and 2 for flora of Kampong Chhnang and Kampong Thom, respectively (Toyama *et al.* 2012, 2013), we hope this guide will be great helpful and useful for many people who are interested in Cambodian plants.



Acanthaceae *Thunbergia fragrans* Roxb. Kmer name: វល្លិត្នោតស [Vor Tnot Sor]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small climber, not rare in the PSPs. Specimen No. 4172 Anacardiaceae Buchanania lanzan Spreng. Kmer name: កន្លួត ព្រោង [Kantual Prong]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree, 10 m tall and the 5th dominant tree in the PSPs. Lower surface of leaves are densely villous. Specimen No. 1140, 1148, 1149, 1151, 1389

Anacardiaceae Buchanania siamensis Miq. Kmer name: ហាំងជ័យ [Laing Chey]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree rarely found in the PSPs. Specimen No. 1385

Anacardiaceae Lannea coromandelica (Houtt.) Merr. Kmer name: មនស្វា [Morn Sva]



Distribution: Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree, found in the CF. Specimen No. 4167

Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree, deciduous, common in the dry deciduous forest at

Distribution: Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Shrub, 1–4 m tall, occasionally found in the CF. Specimen No. 4181


Annonaceae *Miliusa velutina* Hook.f. & Thomson Kmer name: ស្នាក្រាបី [Sma Krobei]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Pakistan, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree, 10 m tall, occasionally found around the PSPs

Annonaceae *Polyalthia cerasoides* (Roxb.) Bedd. Kmer name: ຼ້າກາພ [Kray]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Shrub, 5 m tall, only one individual found at outside of the PSPs. Specimen No. 1377

Annonaceae Xylopia pierrei Hance Kmer name: ໂຕາເມເນ [Kray Sor]



Distribution: Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree, common in the PSPs, the vicinity of PSPs and the CF. Photos were taken in Kampong Thom. Specimen No. 1412

Apocynaceae Aganonerion polymorphum Pierre Kmer name: វាល្លិដ្ឌីដ [Vor Thnoeung]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Woody vine occasionally found in the vicinity of the PSPs. Specimen No. 1181

Apocynaceae Amphineurion marginatum (Roxb.) D.J.Middleton Kmer name: វល្លិក្រឡាំកែ [Vor Krolampe]



Distribution: Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Vine, rare in the PSPs, but common in the thickets and roadside. Specimen No. 1387

Apocynaceae Holarrhena curtisii King & Gamble Kmer name: ອີກເສາະຊາ [Teukdoas khla]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Shrub, up to 1 m tall, occasionally found in and around the PSPs. Specimen No. 1188, 4218

Apocynaceae *Streptocaulon juventas* (Lour.) Merr. Kmer name: វល្លិដុយ [Vor Chuy]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Climber, commonly found in the vicinity of the PSPs. Specimen No. 4210 Arecaceae *Phoenix loureiroi* Kunth Kmer name: ដូងព្រះ [Daung Preah]



Distribution: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, India, Laos, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Palm, having 1m tall trunk, occasionally found in and around PSPs.

Specimen No. 1178, 4213

Asteraceae Acilepis squarrosa D.Don Kmer name: ស្មៅរុយ [Smao Ruy]



Distribution: Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Herb, 40 cm tall, locally common in ths PSPs. This species is easily recognized by its scabrous oblanceolate leaves and sessile flowers in the axils of the leaves.

Bignoniaceae Stereospermum cylindricum Pierre ex Dop Kmer name: សង្ក្រតភ្ជាតា [Sangkuot Thmat]



Distribution: Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree 12 m tall, found in vicinitiy of the PSPs. Specimen No. 1392, 4186

Bixaceae *Cochlospermum religiosum* (L.) Alston Kmer name: ຕັບູງາសភ្នំ [Kabas Phnom]



Distribution: Cambodia, India, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small deciduous tree, only one individual found in the CF. Specimen No. 4169

Combretaceae Terminalia alata B.Heyne ex Roth Kmer name: ឈ្លីកា [Chhlik]



Distribution: Cambodia, India, Laos, Myanmar, Nepal, Thailand, Vietnam.
Observation: Tree, 10 m tall, 2nd dominant tree in the PSPs. This species is distinct from other three *Terminalia* species by young leaves densely covered with hairs and larger fruits 3–6 cm width with 5 wings.

Combretaceae Terminalia calamansanay Rolfe Kmer name: ដើមព៣លខែ [Popeal Khe]





Distribution: Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam.

Observation: Tree, only one individual found in the CF. The fruits have 2 wings, but easily distinct from *T. corticosa* by its thinner and narrower leaves.

Specimen No. 4178

Combretaceae *Terminalia chebula* Retz. Kmer name: லுப் [Samor]



Distribution: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Laos, Malaysia (introduced), Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree, 10 m tall, occasionally found in the plots. The fruits of this species do not have wings. Specimen No. 1166, 1167 

Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand.
Observation: Relatively rare tree compared to other three *Terminalia* species. We found two individuals, one in the plot (KR01-tree no. 28) and another in the vicinity of the PSPs. This species is characterized by its 2-winged fruits.
Specimen No. 1374, 1398

Convolvulaceae Argyreia mekongensis Gagnep. & Courchet Kmer name: វល្លិកាន្លងក្នំ [Vor Kanlong Phnom]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam.
Observation: Woody climber, common in the PSPs. This species is easily distinguished from *A. osyrensis* by its elliptic to oblong leaves with obtuse base. Calyx and bracts are yellowish hispid and enclose berries.

Convolvulaceae Argyreia osyrensis Choisy Kmer name: វល្លិត្រាចៀកទន្សាយ [Vor Trocheak Tunsay]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Woody climber, found in the vicinity of the PSPs. Specimen No. 4215 Convolvulaceae Merremia quinata (R.Br.) Ooststr. Kmer name: វល្លិត្អើក [Vor Ta Euk]



Distribution: Australia, Cambodia, China, Indonesia, Myanmar, New Guinea, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam.

Observation: Perennial herbaceous twiner, found in the PSPs. This speices is characteristic in palmately compound leaves with 5 leaflets and creamy yellow corolla.

Cycadaceae Cycas siamensis Miq. Kmer name: ປັ່ដ່ [Brong]



Distribution: Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: This Cycas was occasionally found in the PSPs and seemed to be tolerant to fire. Specimen No. 1172

Dilleniaceae *Dillenia hookeri* Pierre Kmer name: ភ្លាូជាត [Phlou Bat]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Deciduous shrub, usually less than 1 m tall, and scattered around the PSPs. Specimen No. 1186

Dilleniaceae *Dillenia obovata* (Blume) Hoogland Kmer name: කූර් [Phlou Thom]



Distribution: Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Deciduous tree, 10 m tall. We found only one individual in the vicinity of the PSPs. Specimen No. 1396




Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: This is a climber common in and around both the PSPs and the CF. Specimen No. 4189

Dipterocarpaceae *Dipterocarpus intricatus* Dyer Kmer name: ຄາເພີ [Trach]




Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Deciduous tree. We found only one individuals at outside of the PSPs. Photos were taken in Kampong Thom. Specimen No. 1372

Dipterocarpaceae Dipterocarpus tuberculatus Roxb. Kmer name: ஜு☆ [Khlong]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Deciduous tree and the most dominant species in the PSPs (53 % of the total number of trunk). Specimen No. 1142, 1147

Dipterocarpaceae *Shorea obtusa* Wall. ex Blume Kmer name: འྲོྱ̃̃̃̃̃̃̃̃ [Phchek]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree up to 12 m tall, and the second dominant species in the PSPs. Specimen No. 1141, 1144, 1155, 1161

Dipterocarpaceae Shorea siamensis Miq. Kmer name: ກໍ່ເສກຼໍ [Raing Phnom]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Deciduous tree up to 10 m tall, the 6th dominant speices in the PSPs. Specimen No. 1143, 1157, 1160

Droseraceae Drosera indica L. Kmer name: ស្មៅសន្ស៊ើមដួច [Smao Sanseumduoch]



Distribution: Widely distributed from Africa, E and SE Asia to Australia. Observation: Annual herb found in moist ground from the rainy season to the beginning of the dry season.

Euphorbiaceae *Thyrsanthera suborbicularis* Pierre ex Gagnep. Kmer name: រដ្ឋដព្រះអាទិត្យ [Rongvong Preah Atith]



Distribution: Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small shrub, 20 cm tall, occasionally found in the PSPs and their vicinities. Specimen No. 1176, 4179 Fabaceae Bauhinia bracteata (Benth.) Graham ex Baker Kmer name: វល្លិ ខ្លែងពណ៍ [Vor Khlengpor]



Distribution: Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Woody climber, found in the thickets beside the PSPs. Specimen No. 4216 Fabaceae Bauhinia malabarica Roxb. Kmer name: ជើងកោ [Cheungko]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree, found in the CF. Specimen No. 4170

Fabaceae Butea monosperma (Lam.) Taub.

Kmer name: רובז [Char]





Distribution: Cambodia, China (cultivated), Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Deciduous tree, found beside the PSPs. Specimen No. 4217

Fabaceae *Clitoria hanceana* Hemsl. Kmer name: កាម្រើកកុម្ព [Kamreukkum]




Distribution: Cambodia, China, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Climber, common in the vicinity of the PSPs. Specimen No. 1175

Fabaceae Dalbergia nigrescens Kurz Kmer name: ស្លួល [Snuol]



Distribution: Cambodia, India, Laos, Myanmar, Nepal, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Deciduous tree, occasionally found in the vicinity of the PSPs. Specimen No. 1139

Fabaceae *Dendrolobium lanceolatum* Schinedl. Kmer name: ទ្រនំបង្ហួយ [Tronum Bangkuoy]




Distribution: Cambodia, China, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small shrub, 1–1.5 m tall, common in and around the PSPs. Specimen No. 1171

Fabaceae *Millettia erythrocalyx* Gagnep. Kmer name: ម្រេញ [Morrenh]



Distribution: Cambodia, Chian, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree, occasionaly found near the PSPs. Specimen No. 1393

Fabaceae *Pterocarpus macrocarpus* Kurz Kmer name: 뗥넒 [Thnong]




Distribution: Cambodia, India, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree, 10 m tall, we found one individual beside the PSPs. Specimen No. 1391 Fabaceae *Spatholobus parviflorus* Kuntze Kmer name: 出行出げ [Dork Cav]




Distribution: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam.

Observation: Woody climber, occasionally found near the PSPs. This is a common and widely distributed species in dry dipterocarpus forest in SE Asia.

Fabaceae Uraria lagopodioides (L.) DC. Kmer name: ຕຣູພຕໍ່ເບຸຕ [Kantuy Kamprok]



 Distribution: Australia, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Japan, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam.
 Observation: Herb, somewhat common in the PSPs.
 Specimen No. 1183 Fabaceae Vigna minima (Roxb.) Ohwi & H.Ohashi var. minima Kmer name: សណ្តែកខ្មោច [Sandek Khmoch]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, New Guinea, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Climber, common in both the PSPs and the CF. This species is distinct from V.

dalzelliana in having smaller stipules (1.5 mm vs. usually 3.0 mm long).



Fabaceae Xylia xylocarpa (Roxb.) W.Theob var. kerrii (Craib & Hutch.) I.C.Nielsen Kmer name: ស្ក្រាម [Sokrom]



Distribution: Bangladesh, Cambodia, India, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree, 10 m tall, occasionally found in the PSPs. This species is common and widely distributed from the dry dipterocarpus forest to the mixed evergreen forest at lowland.

Hypericaceae Cratoxylum formosum (Jack) Benth. & Hook.f. ex Dyer Kmer name: 10) : [Lo Ngieng]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam.

Observation: Deciduous tree, 6–8 m tall, occasionally found beside the PSPs. Specimen No. 1378

Lecythidaceae Careya arborea Roxb. Kmer name: போற்ப [Kandol]



Distribution: Afghanistan, Cambodia, India, Laos, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam.

Observation: Deciduous tree, 6–10 m tall, occasinoally found in the PSPs. This species is common and widely distributed in the dry dipterocarpus forest.

Leeaceae *Leea guineense* G.Don Kmer name: ຕາເຼດານ [Bay Kream]



Distribution: Africa, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, New Guinea, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Herb, 1 m tall, common in the PSPs and the CF. Specimen No. 4180

Leeaceae *Leea thorelii* Gagnep. Kmer name: ជាយក្តាំង [Bay Kdaing]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Herb, 60 cm tall, sparsely found in the CF. Specimen No. 4219

Loganiaceae Strychnos nux-blanda A.W.Hill Kmer name: ស្លែងព្រវៀក [Sleng Broviek]



Distribution: Cambodia, India, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Small tree, 6 m tall, occasionally found in and around the PSPs. Specimen No. 1169

Malpighiaceae *Hiptage* sp. [cf. *candicans* Hook.f.] Kmer name: ຄຳເປັນີ [Krobei Bei]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Scandent tree, 5 m tall, only one individual collected in the PSPs. This is considered to be *H. candicans* in its having leaves densely pubescent on lower surface. We need fertile materials for conclusive identification.

Malvaceae *Bombax anceps* Pierre Kmer name: $i \in [Roka]$




Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree, only one individual found in the CF. Specimen No. 4221

Malvaceae *Bombax cambodiense* Pierre Kmer name: 3 [Roka]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, Myanmar, Thailand. Observation: Tree, only one individual found in the CF. This species is sometimes treated as a variety of *B. anceps*, but distinct in having larger leaves, tomentose lower surface, and more lateal veins.

Malvaceae *Grewia abutilifolia* Vent. ex Juss. Kmer name: ກຸລາຄຸເຣ [Pophlea Toch]

Malvaceae Grewia eriocarpa Juss. Kmer name: ពភ្លាអាចម៍សត្វ [Pophlea Achsat]



Distribution: Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailnad, Vietnam.

Observation: Small tree, sparsely found in the CF. This species is characterized by its asymmetrical ovate leaves with glaucous lower surface.

Malvaceae Grewia hirsuta Vahl Kmer name: ជាយក្រៀម [Bay Kream Chhlmol]



Distribution: Bangladesh, Cambodia, India, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam.

Observation: Small shrub, sparsely found in the CF. This species has oblong to lanceolate leaves covered by dense hairs beneath.

Malvaceae *Helicteres angustifolia* L. Kmer name: សំបុកជាស [Sambok Cheas]



Distribution: Australia, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam.

Observation: Small shrub, 1–2 m tall, common in dry dipterocarpus stands. We collected this species in a similar habitat in Kampong Thom.

Malvaceae Hibiscus glanduliferus Craib Kmer name: បើសព្រៃ [Beus Prey]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand. Observation: Small shrub, occasionally found in the vicinity of the CF. Specimen No. 4208

Malvaceae Waltheria indica L. Kmer name: កន្ទាំងបាយស ឈ្មោល [Kantaingbayso Chhmol]



Distribution: Native to neotropics Observation: Erect subshrub, 0.8 m tall, locally abundant in the vicinity of the CF. This species is characterized by densely puberulent branchlets and leaves.

Melastomataceae Osbeckia chinensis L. Kmer name: បាយញោបាតា [Baaynhenh Bat]



Distribution: Australia, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Japan, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Erect to small shrub, 30 cm tall. Flowers are 2.5 cm in diam. with 4 pale purple petals. Specimen No. 4211 Meliaceae Azadirachta indica A.Juss. Kmer name: ស្ពៅ [Sdao]




Distribution: Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Laos, Myanmar, Sir Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree, 10 m tall, one individual collected in the vicinity of the CF. Myrtaceae Syzygium fruticosum DC. Kmer name: ក្រាដក្រហម [Pring Kroham]



Distribution: Australia, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Tree, occasionally found in the PSPs. Specimen No. 1185

Olacaceae Olax scandens Roxb. Kmer name: দান্দ্রের্ণ [Orphtuok]



Distribution: Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Woody vine, occasionally found in the vicinity of the PSPs. Specimen No. 1376

Orobanchaceae Centranthera cochinchinensis (Lour.) Merr.

Kmer name: unknown

Passifloraceae Adenia viridiflora Craib Kmer name: វិល្លិក្រណាវ [Vor Kronav]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam. Observation: Climber, only one individual was found in the outside of the PSPs. Leaves have 2 glands at base. Specimen No. 1375

Phyllanthaceae Aporosa villosa Baill. Kmer name:) [다 너 [Krung]







Distribution: Cambodia, China, Vietnam. Observation: Woody vine, found in the PSPs. This species is characterized by the leaves with lower surface densely brown tomentose. Specimen No. 1180 Zingiberaceae *Curcuma singularis* Gagnep. Kmer name: ເງິນເມີນ [Charhuoy]



Distribution: Cambodia, Laos, Thailand. Observation: Herb, occasionally found in the PSPs. Inflorescences, ca. 10 cm tall, appeared near the ground in June. Leaves do not expand in a flowering season. Specimen No. 1158
